


- For many new families to hear about camp


## PRAISE

## Executive Director Update

**THANK YOU FOR BEING INVOLVED AT CAMP!** If we missed seeing you at the Friendraising Dessert Nights, the included Year End Dashboard has the stats about what the impact has been. Our desire is that people like you know more and ask the right questions to help us grow and improve in sharing the Gospel.

A new way to engage and invite families was the Christmas Parade in November. JD and Dayna created a ridiculous parade float and as we rolled past the 6000ish spectators we handed out popsicles and declared it was "25 degrees and sunny everyday at camp." We got a lot of laughs but also earned the opportunity to hand out over 800 summer brochures. People were reaching out with excitement and wanted to engage with what we are about. Our Mission Statement is to... *"Glorify God by making Jesus Christ known by word and deed through camping and conference programs"*

Ephesians 2:8-9 reminds us that Christ is the gift and reason for this season **"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God not by works, so that no one can boast."** Thousands of people this year were invited into this gift of grace as they attended camp for all sorts of events. Our site, programs and staff all exist to serve the Church's desire to evangelize the lost, especially children and youth.

God's word is going to all guests now with new maps that have scripture boldly on them. Huge new art pieces hang in the gym that teach Biblical ideas. We have started payment plans so that more families can afford to book their spot early and pay fees away from December and January which are hard financial months. With supporters like you we have raised the funds to take on projects like building portable shelters to increase dining capacity, replacing dock boards, redoing dangerous decks, renovating entrances to buildings to lower winter risks and more!

There is nothing impacting youth to the scale that camps do each year. It takes an army to make camp happen and we need people like you to continue praying, serving, attending, giving or joining that team. We raised \$82,000 at the Friend-Raising Dessert Nights which is putting new ideas into action (as listed above), increasing the monthly support of our team and taking a chunk out of the \$240,000 we need donated annually for our general operations. This was great and there are still great needs to fill, read through the attached info on how to give and get involved.
